I have been working in gynaecologic oncology for 20 years now. As the founding member of ENYGO, I had the pleasure to establish friendship with many European excellent collegues. After local and international training I have dedicated 100% of my activity to the care of gynaecological cancer patients. I became the head of the national tertiary gynaecologic cancer centre in Hungary and now we have a considerable caseload, performing more than 750 gyn/onc surgeries and more than 2000 chemotherapy cycles a year. We succesfully initiated the first robotic surgery program in the country, we created a high volume HIPEC centre and succesfully accredited the so far only Hungarian ESGO accredited centre. We gained ESGO accreditation for training and for ovarian cancer surgery also. We collaborate in multiple international/ESGO/ENGOT trials, being important members of the CEEGOG where I serve as scientific board member. I therefore witnessed the benefits of the close collaboration with ESGO and I am motivated to work together with this succesful organisation to further improve the care in our region.

To my opinion, ESGO is a fantastic example how an international society has to work bringing together motivated experts. My vision is to move forward gynaecologic cancer care in our region with the following ways: facilitate centralization of gyn/onc activity in Eastern and Central Europe; organising workshops as education and training is a key component of our activity and finally trying to provide help to low ressource countries and regions to be able to improve their care.

In Eastern Europe we can be proud of our surgical education and volume, it is imperative that excellent Eastern Europen surgeons could share their experience and participate actively in European education programs. As we are experienced in ultrasound guided procedures in gynaecologic oncology, I am planning to implement training and education in this field.
