I applicate for ESGO Council Member 2024-2028 for 5 most important reasons.

Firstly, I would like to promote international collaboration between oncological surgeons and gynecological oncologist – after attending ESSO Advanced Course on the Management of HIPEC after CRS Hamburg, Germany I had an impression that ESGO may work in that filed for better oncological outcomes, especially to cooperate with Peritoneal Surface Malignancies associated societies.

Secondly, I would like to promote international workshops on cadavers free of charge for young residents and specialist in gynecological oncology and surgery – This year it will be a second edition of such workshops for participants from Poland that enable young oncologist to learn from top of the top gynecologist from Poland and colleagues for other ESGO counties. That area must be developed especially in Central and Eastern Europe countries, including Poland. This required workshops for doctors, nurses as well as creating applications for patients (or making existing one available in national languages) and most importantly, with all patient advocacy groups. Only in that way the diagnosis, treatment and follow up will be holistic, ensuring the best care for every patient.
