Motivation letter

Dear Madam/sir,

I am happy to write this motivation letter for the application to be nominated for the ESGO Council 2024–2028. As gynecologic oncologist I am working at the Radboud university medical center Nijmegen (NL).

As past chair of the ENITEC network (2019-2022), I have learned the importance of European connections-collaborations to improve healthcare for women with gynecological cancers. Gynecological cancers are relatively rare when compared to many other cancers, hence coordination within ESGO will enhance our knowledge by trials and international guidelines in the aim to achieve comparable quality of care among all European women with gynecological cancer.

In my daily work I am active on all domains that are envisioned by the ESGO: Prevention, Research, Excellence in care and Education. My research is focused on translational and personalized endometrial cancer. Interestingly, as part of this research I am actively involved in projects to implement healthy lifestyle as part of routine cancer care in order to improve sustainable life style changes. As about 60% of all cancers are related to modifiable risk factors, lifestyle will be highly relevant in future healthcare, underlined by increasing health care costs. In the last decades technical innovations have improved the understanding of cancer behavior resulting in personalized treatment options. Yet, for an actual personalized approach better understanding of patients' perspectives is crucial to achieve these goals. Since two years I am chair of the medical advisory board of OLIJF, Dutch patient advocacy group of female cancer. In this position I have learned that perspectives of women with cancer, often differ from us as health care providers, with more focus on quality of life and proper balance with quantity of life. This may be challenging for ministries of health who often focus on survival benefit as ultimate goal. ESGO can contribute to these national and international discussions with focus on well-being of women with gynecological cancers.

I am looking forward to contribute to these future challenges with support of my application by the chair of the Dutch working party Gyn-Onc (Brigittte Slangen) and the chair of the Gyn-Onc DGOG (Christianne Lok).
