# Ovarian Cancer Surgical Week

Policlinico Universitario Agostino Gemelli | Rome, Italy December 1-5, 2025

### Objective:

The surgical management of ovarian cancer has become an indispensable marker of subspecialty in gynecologic oncology. Whatever the setting, primary, interval, secondary, tertiary or more, required surgical skills extend far beyond the management of the genital tract diseases. However, caseload and learning opportunities are required to acquire and maintain proficiency. In addition, assessing the chances to achieve complete resection and preventing, or adequately managing, surgical complications is crucial. Access to targeted treatment for maintenance and recurrence has recently introduced new therapeutic opportunities, however without reducing the need of mastering surgical resection of abdominal and if necessary thoracic disease. The objective of the course is to make young and less young gynecologic oncologists comfortable with the different procedures required to achieve complete resection of ovarian cancer.

#### Format:

Full week seminar dedicated to surgery of ovarian cancer, combining morning live surgeries and surgical technique lectures with videos in the afternoons. Face-to-face interaction with the Gemelli faculty will be favored because of limited number of on-site participants. However, online registration is available for colleagues who do not consider travelling to Rome.

One of the surgeries will be performed on the cadaver model in order to illustrate surgical anatomy and templates, the other surgeries (VATS, upper abdomen procedures, bulky nodes resection, posterior nerve sparing exenteration with douglassectomy, etc..) will be broadcasted from the Gemelli operating room. Ongoing surgical clinical approaches will also been shown. World-class experts will moderate online the live surgery sessions. In the afternoons, with the contribution of the Gemelli team and of the world-class faculty, emphasis will be given on detailing surgical techniques. Long time will be dedicated to discussions.
